

Kindergarten

Kindergarten is your child's introduction to formal learning. It is a very important time for children to learn social skills that will be utilized for the next 12 years of school. Our program balances academics and social skills. The curriculum encompasses the entire day with a crucial 45 "rest period".

Below are just a few of the exciting skills your child will learn of the course of the school year:

- 👂 Half hour of Spanish language instruction 
- 👂 Writing UPPER and lower case letters, including their name
- 👂 Rhyming, phonetics, size order, and opposites
- 👂 Addition, subtraction, greater and less than
- 👂 Six major animal groups & their characteristics
- 👂 Seasons, land forms & water, and the solar system
- 👂 Community helpers & their parents occupation too!
- 👂 Parts of the body 
- 👂 Address, phone number, and full name
- 👂 Social and emotional development

- 11:00 - 11:30 Structured activity (Science Activity, Art Project, Cooking Project, etc.)
- 11:30 - 12:00 Outside play time 
- 12:00 - 12:20 Bathroom break
- 12:20 - 12:50 Lunch time and social hour
- 12:50 - 2:45 Naptime 
- 2:45 - 3:10 Wake-up and bathroom break
- 3:10 - 3:30 Snack time and social hour
- 3:30 - 4:15 Outside play time 
- 4:15 - 4:45 Free play — Centers
- 4:45 - 5:00 Clean-up (prepare for departure)
- 5:00 - 6:00 Activity room — quiet time, movie hour, prepare to leave
